Schedule will be revised according to the classes that fill.

1 - 3 - Open Hunter - Fences 2' & 2'6". *VHSA for 2'6" only.*

4 - 6 - Pony Hunter - Fences 2' & 2'6". *VHSA Small-Medium Ponies at 2' and Large Ponies at 2'6".*

7 - 9 - Novice Equitation - Riders in their first or second year of showing over fences. Simple changes are not penalized. Fences 2'.

10 - 12 - Green Hunter - Open to horses in their first or second year and ponies in their first year of showing over fences. Fences 2' or 2'6". *VHSA for 2' Small Medium Ponies, 2'6" Large Ponies and Horses only.*

13a - 15a - Children's Hunter - Open or Junior riders. Fences 2' or 2'6". *VHSA for 2'6" only.*

13b - 15b- Adult Hunter - Open to Amateur riders. Fences 2' or 2'6". *VHSA for 2'6" only.*

16 - 18 - Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences. Fences 18" or 2'.

19 - SHSA/VHSA Equitation - Open to juniors and amateurs. Fences 2' or 2'6". *VHSA for Small/Medium Ponies at 2' and Large ponies and horses at 2'6" only.*

10 Minute Schooling Break for Beginner Equitation

20 - 22 - Beginner Equitation - Riders in their first year of showing over fences. May trot or canter 4 over a simplified course, no higher than 18". Flat class is walk trot only. May not cross enter into any over fences class.

10 Minute Schooling Break for Pleasure

23 - Model Hunter in Hand - Judged on conformation, way of going, soundness and suitability to be a hunter. Shown in a snaffle bridle. Yearlings may be shown in a halter.

24 - All Breed Conformation 2 & Under - Judged closest to the standard of which their breed represents.

25 - All Breed Conformation 3 & Over - Judged closest to the standard of which their breed represents.

26 - Open Showmanship - Judged pattern in hand. Shown in a halter (Western) or bridle (English/Hunter). Judged on grooming, attire, fitness and performance. Use the "quarter system" when maneuvering around horse.

27 - Leadline

28 - 30 - Hunter Pleasure - Class 29 is Go As You Please. *VHSA.*

31 - 33 - Maiden Walk Trot Equitation - Riders 9 years and under who have not won a year end award in this division. May cross enter into Beginner Pleasure and Beginner Equitation.

61 - 63 - Beginner Pleasure - Open to horses and ponies. To be shown at the Walk/Trot only.

34 - 36 - Green Pleasure - Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing. Shown at a walk and a trot but must canter in class 35.

37 - 39 - Walk-Trot Equitation - Open to riders 10 years of age and older in their 1st or 2nd year of showing who have not won a year end award for this division. May cross enter into Beginner Pleasure and Beginner Equitation.

40 - Junior Equitation - Open to riders 17 years and under. To be judged at a walk, trot (jog) and canter (lope.) Additional tests may be asked.

41 - Novice Equitation - Open to riders in their first year of showing at the canter. Tests may be asked.

42 - Adult Equitation - Open to riders 18 years and older. To be judged at a walk, trot (jog) and canter (lope). Tests may be asked.

43 - 45 - Novice Pleasure - Open to all riders in their first year of showing at a canter. Walk, trot and canter. Class 44 is Go As You Please.

46 - 48 - Junior Pleasure - Open to all riders 17 years and under. Judged at the Walk, trot (jog) and canter (lope). Class 47 is Go As You Please.

49 - 51 - Open Walk/Trot Pleasure - Open to all riders and disciplines. To be judged at a walk and trot (jog) only. To be judged according to the standards of the discipline exhibited.

52 - 54 - Western Pleasure - Judged at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein. Horses 5 years and under may be shown in a bosal or ring snaffle with 2 hands. Class 53 is Go As You Pleasure.

55 - 57 - Open Walk/Trot 30 & Over - Open to riders over 30 and all disciplines. Judged at a walk, trot (jog). Judged according to the standards of the discipline exhibited.

58 - 60 - Open Pleasure - Open to all riders and all disciplines. Shown at the walk, trot (jog) and canter (lope). To be judged according to the standards of the discipline exhibited. Class 59 is Go As You Pleasure.
